### ACTIVITY TIMES

Finishing times printed on the program are approximate only. Circumstances such as the number in the group, fitness levels and weather on the day may delay or cause the activity to finish earlier or later than the printed time.

### ACTIVITY PAYMENTS

Cash only payment should be made to your guide at the start of your activity. All prices include GST.

The child rate is for children 4 years to 15 years. Family rate applies to a family group of 2 adults and 2 children. Child rate applies to additional children. An adult must accompany all children under 18 years.

### WHAT TO BRING

Wear sturdy shoes with good tread. Carry warm, wet weather gear, a hat, sun cream, food and water on all activities. This is particularly important for all walks.

### ACTIVITY GRADING

- Easy: Suitable for most people but take care with children.  
Medium: Some steps or steep areas, suitable for people who regularly exercise.  
Hard: Only for fit, experienced walkers. Steps and /or steep sections. Visitors with heart or breathing problems should not attempt these walks.

For your safety and wellbeing please discuss any medical conditions you have that may affect your ability to complete an activity at the time of booking or with your guide on the day.

### DISCOVERY FOR SCHOOLS

The Kosciuszko Education Centre also runs an extensive education program for schools. The Centre's summer and indoor winter programs align with syllabus learning outcomes for K to 12 students. Ask for a program outline if you would like more information.

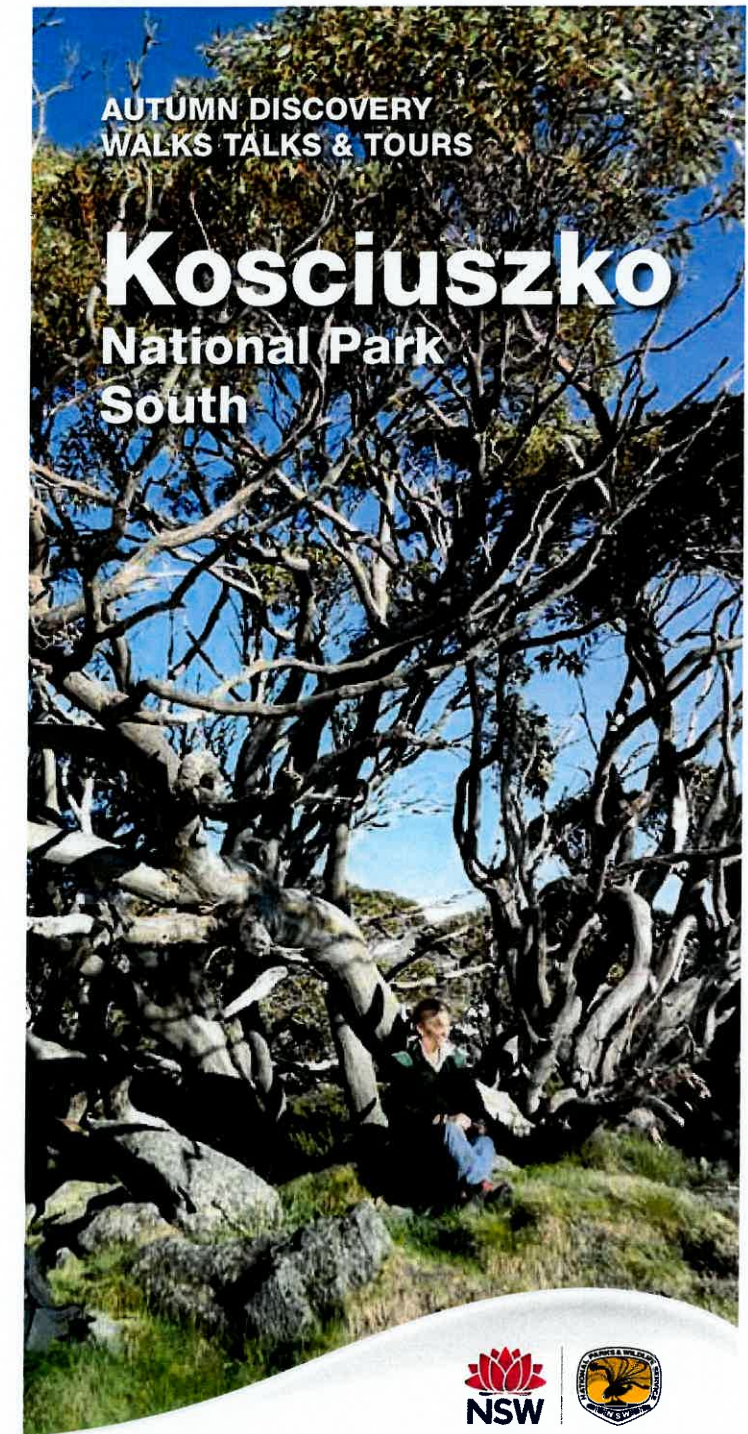
