*To Guthega Lessees,*

*NPWS Perisher Team are making some changes to improve waste management across the Perisher Range Resorts. There's a few tweaks to the waste management operation that NPWS would like your assistance for the 2017 snow season.*

*1/ the ideal recycling situation for Guthega is to deposit comingled items (plastic bottles, cans and glass) into the yellow 'recycling' skips without the storage or carry bag. Of course this ideal situation also includes the exclusion of non-recyclable material (contaminants) from entering the recycling skips as well.*

*2/ however, if bags are to be used then NPWS would like you to use clear plastic bags. Clear plastic bags allow NPWS staff and contractors to remove the bag if the contents contain too many contaminants. The good news is that NPWS is prepared to supply clear plastic bags in the same way that they have been provided to lodges in Smiggin Holes and Perisher Valley. NPWS would deliver these bags to Guthega lodges before or over the June Long-weekend.*

*3/ The NPWS plastic bags can be used to store and carry items to the skips and re-used. If managing the bags beyond the single use for recyclables is not an option, then consider using the bag for the next load of waste. If the bag and its contents are to be deposited into the recycling skip, then NPWS requests that you untie the bag before depositing it into the skip. This will allow NPWS Perisher staff and contractors easier access to empty the contents.*

*Please inform NPWS if you don't wish to receive a supply of clear plastic bags.*
