NPWS - UPDATE ON ROADS AND PARKING

Here's a summary from NPWS for your members:

Perisher Valley

Roads open (status D). Overnight parking restricted to authorised vehicles displaying RMV or LPP permits (issued from Perisher NPWS office). Parking in designated lodge spaces only.

Note: Overnight parking available at Smiggin Holes carpark for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. Map below shows location. Perisher will be running shuttle buses from Smiggin Holes to Perisher Valley.

Resort Management Vehicles (RMV) – these permits are issued to lodge management for guest and business management purposes. Generally this is a lodge with a full time manager so does not apply to many Club lodges.

Lodge Parking Permits (LPP) – are issued according to the number of car spaces available at the premises. We have determined this based on the available hardstand area and the Australian Standard for car parking. LPPs are issued from the NPWS Perisher office free of charge. Their purpose is to prevent damage to surrounding areas and minimise impact to vehicle movements when too many cars try to park at a lodge and exceed the available area.

We maintain a list of RMV and LPP available for each premise. In most cases premises have at least one LPP or RMV available. I suggest if lodges are unsure they contact us on 6457 4444 to clarify.

Smiggin Holes

Roads open and parking allowed in designated lodge spaces. Overnight parking at Smiggin Holes carpark for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights. Map below shows location.

Guthega

Roads open and parking allowed in designated lodge spaces. Overnight parking also available at the Guthega overnight carpark.

RMS Road status at present and for the weekend (unless conditions dramatically change):

Smiggin Holes to Guthega Link Road – open

Kosciusko Road to Charlotte Pass – open
