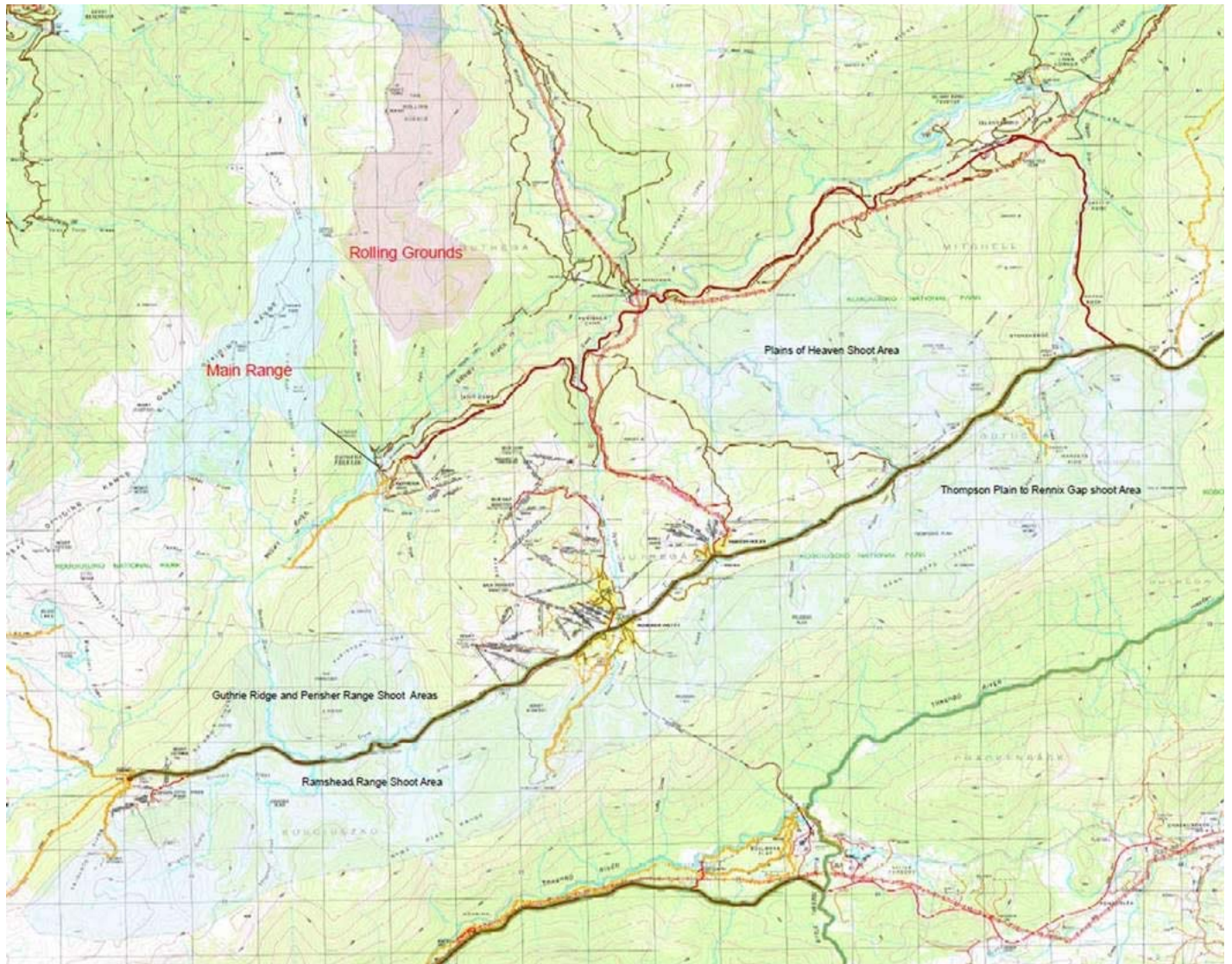

The NSW NPWS will be conducting aerial shooting operations in the following areas on the 16th June 2017: Rolling Grounds, Main Range (North – Mt Anton, Mt Tate and Consett Stephen Pass), Plain of Heaven, Thompson Plains and Rennix Gap, Ramshead Range, Guthrie Ridge Areas . The area where shooting will occur is identified on the attached map, these areas will be closed. A full reconnaissance will be conducted prior to the operation to ensure no walking/cycling individuals or groups are present prior to the operation commencing. Pigs and Deer are the target of this program. This operation is part of a broader pest animal strategy.
