Dear SLOPES Members

By way of reminder, please note:

1. All Clubs are required under their lease from NPWS to have at all times liability and property insurance for their lodges, and to evidence this by providing certificates of currency annually to NPWS as soon as the certificates are received.
2. Failure to comply with these obligations is a breach under the lease which may entitle NPWS to exercise various remedies including the ability for NPWS to arrange it's own cover or ultimately to terminate the lease.

3. JUA Clubs.

For Clubs formerly insured through All Class and choosing to insure through JUA:

- a) Clubs that have completed their paperwork with JUA (see earlier SLOPES emails) will receive from JUA a certificate of currency for their insurances. JUA will also send a copy to NPWS directly, so you do not need to do anything in that regard. We are advised quite a few Clubs have received their certificates already to complete their 2013 renewals;
- b) some Clubs have completed their paperwork and lodged it with JUA but are yet receive their certificates of currency. JUA advises it is processing those cases and certificates should issue shortly (both to the Club and to NPWS);
- c) some Clubs have yet to forward their paperwork to JUA. If you want to participate, you should consider acting without delay. The JUA contact is Amber Spiers - see Amber's details below.

4. Non JUA Clubs.

Clubs formerly with All Class choosing not to insure through JUA and Clubs not part of the former All Class pool need to make their own arrangements to obtain cover and to send certificates of currency to NPWS. For your assistance the relevant contact person at NPWS is:

5. Separately, an issue has arisen in relation to Voluntary Workers Insurance. This is a SLOPES group policy that covers Club volunteers where the Club elects to be part of the cover and pays a proportionate share of the premium. Nearly all Clubs have participated in this in the past few years. The policy fell due last November/December and participating Clubs would have paid a premium of around \$123 each to All Class. The All Class problems have meant that the insurer requires evidence from our Clubs of their payment to confirm cover. We are arranging a broker to help sort out this position and an email will issue specifically on this topic in the next few days with details of what to do.
