SLOPES - Voluntary Workers Insurance - Update

Dear SLOPES Members

In our email of 10 June 2013 we commented on Voluntary Workers Insurance as follows:

5. Separately, an issue has arisen in relation to Voluntary Workers Insurance. This is a SLOPES group policy that covers Club volunteers where the Club elects to be part of the cover and pays a proportionate share of the premium. Nearly all Clubs have participated in this in the past few years. The policy fell due last November/December and participating Clubs would have paid a premium of around \$123 each to All Class. The All Class problems have meant that the insurer requires evidence from our Clubs of their payment to confirm cover. We are arranging a broker to help sort out this position and an email will issue specifically on this topic in the next few days with details of what to do.

We now update Clubs on this cover:

1. Following the Liquidation of All Class Insurance Brokers in April 2013, SLOPES has been advised by the Insurer of the Group Voluntary Workers insurance policy, Accident & Health International, that they will require SLOPES to appoint a Broker to handle the servicing of this account as they do not hold a Retail Licence to enable them to deal directly with the public.
2. Accordingly, SLOPES has appointed Jardine Lloyd Thompson Pty Ltd as our interim Broker with the contact person being Danielle Snelling looking after this account until expiry on the 1st December 2013 at 4pm. Many of you will know Danielle from All Class where, despite the company's difficulties ultimately, Danielle did an excellent job of looking after our Clubs over many years.
3. The Group Voluntary Workers insurance policy covers all Voluntary Workers of the Insured (ie Clubs that participate in the cover), including Directors & Committee Members. Coverage afforded by this policy only applies whilst an Insured Person is engaged in voluntary work authorised by and under the control of the Insured including direct uninterrupted travel to and from such voluntary work.
4. Danielle will be in contact with each SLOPES Member Club directly to provide cover confirmation and policy details.
