Text messages and emails will be sent to all lodge managers 1 week prior to the meetings and a notice will also go up in the Perisher Valley Post office.

Lodges and businesses are invited to send one or two representatives to listen to information, ask questions and contribute comments.

Lodge Managers

Before 2nd June 2014, it would be helpful if all directors of club/lodges could contact the Perisher office and provide in writing the name and contact details of your manager for this season. This will assist us in distributing information in a timely manner throughout the season and avoid delays in processing your applications. Text messaging to lodge managers' mobile phones will again be our main means of communication.

Authorised Parking

Authorised parking in Perisher and Smiggin Holes is very limited, and will be allocated according to eligibility and priority criteria, as outlined in the Alpine Resorts Winter Access information. NPWS cannot guarantee that all requests for authorised parking will be accommodated.

All parking bays will be chained with a NPWS lock until applications are processed and bays assigned. Submissions for authorised parking are to be received by **4pm Monday 2th June 2014**, so that allocations can be processed by the long weekend.

Allocations will be issued according to applications received and not on previous allocations.

Oversnow Vehicles Registration & Licences

The application forms for registration of oversnow vehicles and operator's licences must be completed and submitted to the NPWS Office at Perisher, accompanied by the relevant fees and documentation.

Trades\Contractors

Trades\Contractors vehicular access to lodges requires notification to the NPWS Office at Perisher by a lodge representative, prior to the trade/contractors arriving on-site.

All letters of authorisation should be on letterhead, signed by the applicant's employer (the lessor, director/president of club/lodge) or authorised manager, stating the applicant's needs to operate an oversnow vehicle.

Completed application forms may be presented in person or sent by mail to the NPWS Office at Perisher. All applications sent by mail will be processed and held at the NPWS Office at Perisher for collection by the applicant.
