1. AGM 2015

a) Meeting outcomes

The financial accounts and statements were adopted.

We had informative presentations from our stakeholder speakers (representing Perisher, OEH, NPWS, Department of Planning and Perisher Chamber of Commerce), with interesting questions and answers afterwards.

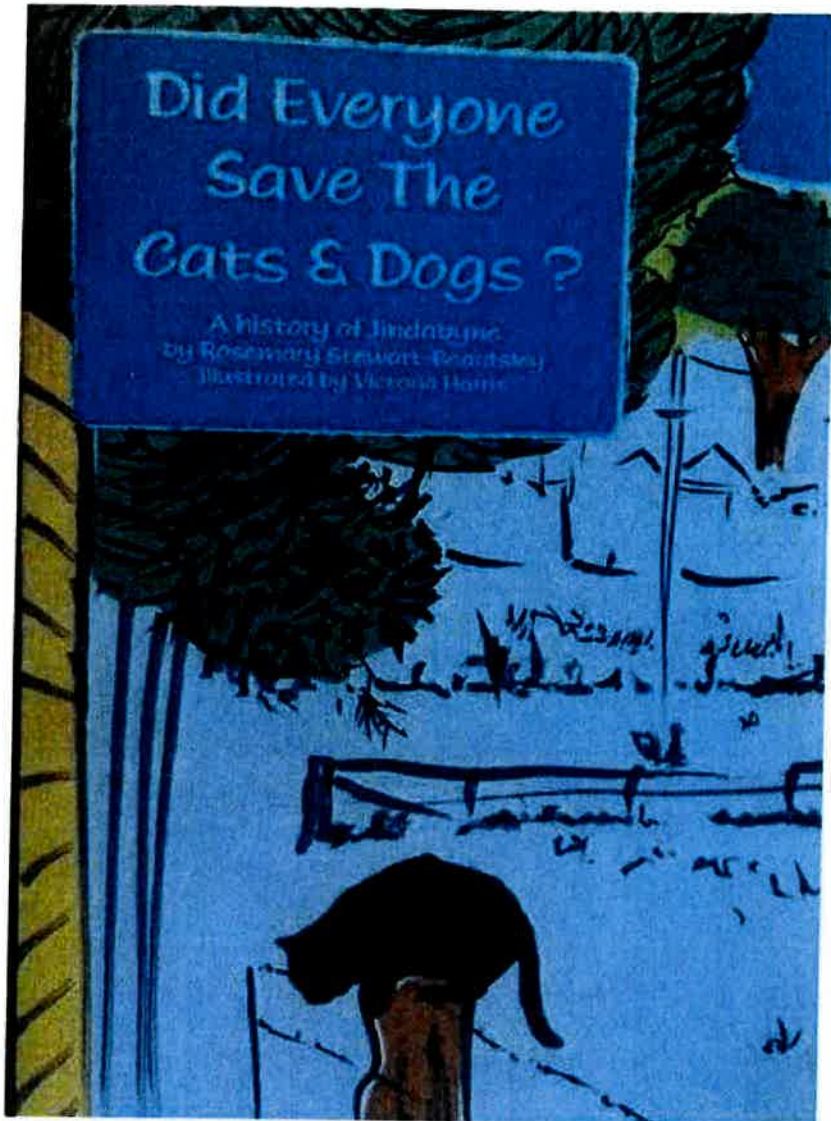

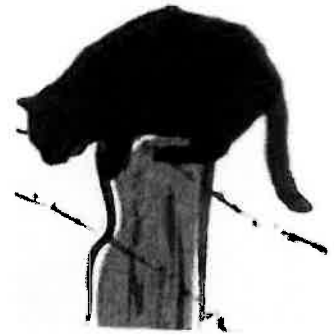
