This DA is seeking to install a "TechnoAlpin snowmaking machine" adjacent to Kaaten Triple Chair at Smiggin Holes.

This DA is on exhibition and open for submissions until 8 August 2017.

The applicant is Perisher Blue Pty Ltd.

The description of the DA is set out in para 4 of the application but is essentially for:

the " Installation of a snow machine that can produce snow at any temperature below 25 degrees celsius" being a "proposed complementary high tech snow machine that can operate independently or in conjunction with the approved Stage 1 and Stage 2 Smiggin Holes snowmaking infrastructure"
