Perisher Range Resorts Lessees,

With the extended season the following arrangements will be in place:

- **Freight shed** operations will continue until COB Friday 11 October 2019.
- **Overnight parking** from Monday 7 October will be permitted at the eastern (toboggan slope) side of **Perisher** car park and within **Smiggin Holes** carpark.
- Lodge **waste collection services** will cease after Sunday 13 October 2019.
- Battery recycling pails supplied at the start of winter should be left in your waste hut for emptying.
- Oversnow passenger services will only operate between **8am and 6pm** from Monday 7 October 2019. Services will cease from **12 noon** Sunday 13 October 2019.

Please also note that Skitube trains and Perisher/Smiggins shuttle buses will not be operating from Monday 7 October 2019.

Perisher Range Resorts Lessees,

NPWS will be accepting solid waste at the Perisher Valley Waste Transfer Station (WTS) from **Sunday 6 October to Friday 11 October 2019**.

We will accept: whitegoods (fridges must be de-gassed and certified), electrical waste, furniture, monitors, televisions, ski gear (only two pairs of skis per lodge).

We will not accept: fridges still containing gas, building waste, timber, chemical waste, fibre cement sheeting, asbestos, paint, mattresses or tyres.

The WTS will be open for solid waste drop off from **10am until 2pm** over this period. Waste not accepted must be taken to Jindabyne Landfill as normal.

Please call the NPWS Perisher Valley office on (02) 6457 4444 for more information and to confirm that your waste will be accepted.

Note: Winter lodge waste collection services will cease on Sunday 13 October 2019. After that all household waste and recycling must be taken to the waste transfer station.
